The Senate Leaders note, however, that the proposed *amicus* brief is accompanied by a proposed congressional redistricting map and an expert report that are not otherwise part of the evidentiary record for this matter. The Court should *not* take these items into consideration because the record is closed and, in any event, "[a]n *amicus curiae* is not a party and cannot raise issues that have not been preserved by the parties." Note to Pa.R.A.P. 531 (quoting *Commonwealth v. Cotto*, 753 A.2d 217, 224 n.6 (Pa. 2000)).

Although the Senate Leaders' counsel is submitting this letter, Bryan Cutler, Speaker of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives, and Kerry Benninghoff, Majority Leader of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives, by their counsel, join in the letter in full.
