Nor will any change to the boundaries achieve an average closer to other courts within the Judicial District. As there are only three district courts and District Court 13-3-01 already comprises nearly two-thirds of our large and rural county, the workload between the district courts cannot be easily shifted.</p>

This police department is located within a relatively large populated area of the eastern district of the county, and is also the municipality in which District Court 13-3-03 is situated. This area has a relatively dense population that surrounds this district court and two school districts within the 13-3-03 that result in fairly active filing of truancy non-traffic offenses. As there are only three district courts and District 13-3-01 already comprises nearly two-thirds of our large and rural county, the workload between the district courts cannot be easily shifted to another court by the redrawing of lines.</p>
