

ORDER

NOW, August 30, 2022, upon consideration of Petitioner’s Petition for Review in the Nature of *Nunc Pro Tunc* Declaratory and Injunctive Relief and Application for Entry of Stipulated Order (Application), and it appearing that the parties have reached an agreement as set forth in the Stipulated [Proposed] Order of Court, filed on August 29, 2022, it is hereby ORDERED that the Application is GRANTED, and the Stipulated [Proposed] Order of Court (Stipulated Order of Court) is approved and entered as an Order of this Court.

It is further ORDERED as follows:

1. Any objections to Petitioner’s name appearing on the November 8, 2022 General Election ballot as the Democratic Party candidate for the 32nd Senatorial District shall be filed within 5 days after Petitioner files the required filing fee and statement of financial interests pursuant to Paragraph 5 of the Stipulated Order of Court.
