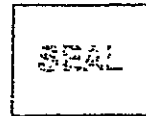

**AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE**

Your affiants are Detective Lawrence Minnick and Sergeant Keith Uhrich of the Lebanon City Police Department, 400 S 8th St. Lebanon, PA 17042. Det. Minnick has been a police officer for 26 years. I have been assigned to the Detective Division for 10 years. Sgt. Uhrich has been a police officer for 23 years. I have been assigned to the Detective division for 20 years. I have been the Sergeant of the Criminal Investigative Division for over 3 years. I have investigated numerous crimes against persons and property during my assignment as a detective to include numerous criminal homicides.

On May 30, 2023, Lebanon City Police were dispatched to 444 N 5th St. Lebanon, PA for a report of gunshots fired. Upon arriving Lebanon City Police units observed multiple gunshot victims to the rear of 444 N 5th St. Three victims: an 8 year old juvenile with initials JP, a 9 year old with initials SP, and a 19-year-old named Joshua Lugo Perez had been on the rear porch of the 444 N 5th St. at the time of the shooting. They were struck by gun fire. All three subsequently died from their gunshot wounds. A 33-year-old occupant of 446 N 5th St, Luis Cancel was also struck by gunfire while inside the residence. He was transported to the hospital for injuries that required emergency medical treatment.

Upon checking the area, police located numerous spent .223 rifle rounds and numerous 9mm handgun rounds located at the Western edge of the playground at the 400 block of Garrett St. just East of Cherry St.

A witness from the 400 blk. of N 4th St. reported to police he saw the shooter in the area where the spent cartridges were later located. The witness also reported to police that a white vehicle left the area travelling east on Arnold St. and then north on 4th St. at a high rate of speed.

A witness known to police who wishes to remain anonymous provided police with a possible suspect with a street name of Flacco. He provided police with several

## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION

Instagram accounts for Flacco.

An adult present in the home at the time of the shooting saw men behind his house at the time of the gunshots. He stated the muzzle flash illuminated the build of one shooter; the build was consistent with Flacco.

On January 17, 2023 and February 7, 2023, Lebanon City Police investigated two separate shootings of Luis Rosario-Rodriguez. During the investigation Alex Torres-Santos was identified as the offender and arrested for both shootings of Luis Rosario-Rodriguez. During the investigation into the February 7, 2023 shooting, Rosario-Rodriguez described a second person who was with the shooter. He described him as a juvenile light skinned male with red hair. Video obtained during the investigation showed Alex Torres-Santos with another male just prior to the shooting of Luis Rosario-Rodriguez. The juvenile male was never identified by Luis Rosario-Rodriguez.

Your affiant observed Instagram photos of Flacco provided to police. They resembled the unidentified subject who was with Alex Torres-Santos on February 7, 2023.

Your affiant was aware Alex Torres-Santos was currently on bail for the two previous shootings. As a condition of his bail, Alex Torres-Santos was placed on house arrest with GPS monitoring. Lebanon City Police made contact with Lebanon County Probation Services to check GPS activity for Alex Torres-Santos on May 30, 2023 around the time of the shooting.

Lebanon County Probation Services reported the GPS activity of Alex Torres-Santos showed him leave his residence located at 434 N 9th St. Apt. 2 at 2142 hours. At 2159 hours, his GPS activity showed him at the intersection of Garrett St and Cherry St. Torres-Santos left the location and travelled to the area of 7th St. and Arnold St. for a short time. He returned to Garrett St. and Cherry St. at 2203 hours and returned to his residence at 2224 hours. GPS monitoring did not show him stop any location for an extended period of time between the time of the shooting and returning to his residence.

Lebanon City Police located video footage of a white vehicle parking in the 400 block of Arnold St. at approximately 2158 hours. Three people exited the vehicle and walked westbound out of the picture. The subjects are observed at 2205 hours running back to the vehicle and fleeing the area.

Evidence at the scene identified two different caliber discharged cases - .223 ammunition and 9mm ammunition. Police located 27 discharged cartridge casings in total. The scene and video thus suggests more than one person fired rounds on scene.

As a result of this investigation, a petition to revoke the bail of Alex Torres-Santos was granted. The order authorized the immediate arrest of Alex Torres-Santos pending a bail revocation hearing. A search warrant was issued for 434 N 9th St Apt 2 to seize Alex Torres-Santos and search for firearms matching evidence recovered at the scene. The Lebanon County Emergency Services Unit (ESU) appeared on scene to arrest Torres-Santos and execute the search warrant. Torres-Santos fled from the residence and was captured by police.

The second subject who fled from the residence was identified as 16 year old James Fernandez-Reyes. He was taken into custody later when he was found hiding 434 N 9th St. apt. 4. The renter of apt. 4 did not give permission for him to be inside the residence.

Upon searching 434 N 9th St. Apt. 4. Lebanon, PA 17046 Lebanon City Police located an Anderson Manufacturing AM-15 Multi Cal rifle in a duffel bag along with several magazines filled with .223 ammunition. The duffel bag was located in the closet. A

small Nike handbag containing drug paraphernalia, a digital scale, a baggie with cocaine residue and a wallet with identification belonging to Alex Torres-Santos was also located in the same closet.

During the investigation a person known to police identified James Fernandez-Reyes and Alex Torres-Santos as two of three shooters. The witness stated that Fernandez-Reyes, an unknown male and Torres-Santos were in possession of a handgun and semi-automatic rifle when they drove to the area of the 400 block of North Cherry Street. The witness reported Alex Torres-Santos fired the Rifle, James Fernandez-Reyes and the other unidentified male fired handguns.

Det. Minnick and Sgt. Buck interviewed Torres-Santos. During an interview with Torres-Santos, he admitted to being present for the shooting and identified Fernandez-Reyes and another unidentified male as persons responsible for firing guns into the rear of 444 and 446 North 5th Street. Torres-Santos said that while he, Fernandez-Reyes and the unknown male were riding in the vehicle, the unknown male and Fernandez-Reyes were armed with a rifle and handgun.

Neither Fernandez-Reyes nor Torres-Santos possess a valid license to carry a concealed firearm.

As the investigation continued, a person known to police identified James Fernandez-Reyes, Alex Torres-Santos and another unidentified male leaving the shooting scene and traveling to the area of 34 Cumberland Street in a white BMW SUV. Upon arrival at 34 Cumberland Street, the unidentified male entered the west side of 34 Cumberland Street discarding a sweater and handgun inside the residence. The male next exited the residence and Fernandez-Reyes, Torres-Santos and this male entered a black in color sedan departing the area.


On June 3, 2023, members of the Lebanon County SWAT team and the Lebanon City Police Department executed a search warrant at 34 Cumberland Street. Residents of 34 Cumberland Street were identified as Tiffany Koziara and Ivan Claudio Rosero. During an interview with Koziara, she identified her boyfriend and father of her son as Rosero. Koziaras stated that she owns a white 2013 BMW SUV, a black 2018 Mercedes Benz sedan and a black 2014 Nissan Maxima. At the time of the execution of search warrant, the white BMW was not on scene.

As a result of the search warrant executed at 34 Cumberland Street, Koziaras cellular telephone was seized and analyzed. Several items of media and messaging were located on her device.

Also on June 3, 2023, a witness known to police was provided a photo array including Rosero's picture. This witness positively identified Rosero as the subject who was firing the handgun towards the rear of 444 N. 5th Street, was driving the white BMW to and from the scene of the shooting and then driving the black sedan from 34 Cumberland Street.

Upon reviewing Rosero's criminal history, your affiants found in February 2017 he was convicted of felony drug law violations. Your affiants also found in November 2017 he was arrested and convicted for felony theft violations. Both of these felony violations prohibit Rosero from owning or possessing firearms.

This is an ongoing investigation with multiple offenders and the location of Rosero is yet unknown. Due to the high-profile nature of this investigation and the need to apprehend Rosero, your Affiant's request that the contents of this probable cause affidavit not be disclosed to prevent the flight of Rosero and any other unidentified individuals and/or the destruction of evidence
